# Advice for Successfully Handling Workers' Compensation Disputes



If you or a loved one has been injured on the job, or has suffered a job—related illness, you may be eligible for California Workers' Compensation benefits.

What's Happening in Southern California can include compensation to replace lost wages as well as coverage for related medical treatments.

Sometimes claims for Workers' Compensation benefits are disputed. Read on for common types of claim disputes:

Eligibility Disputes. If you have received a letter stating that your injury is not covered by Workers' Compensation, it is important to act quickly because of time limitations. You must file an Application for Adjudication of Claim at one of California's 24 Workers' Compensation offices throughout the state and request a hearing.

At this point it is critical to consult with a <u>qualified</u> <u>attorney</u> who can help you navigate the complex California Workers' Compensation system for the best possible outcome for you and your family.

Permanent or Temporary Disability? If you can't work because you are recovering from your injury and unable to do your usual job, you may be eligible for temporary disability benefits. If, however, your condition does not improve, your doctor will send a report to the claims administrator stating that you are permanently disabled. At that time, the Workers' Compensation system will assign you a permanent disability rating to be used (along with date of injury and pre—injury wages) in a formula that will determine the amount of benefits you will receive.

If you don't agree with the doctor or the permanent disability rating, you can request more information and an examination by a <a href="Qualified Medical Evaluator">Qualified Medical Evaluator</a>. At this point, if you have not retained an attorney, you

should consider consulting with <u>an attorney</u>
<u>experienced in California Workers' Compensation</u>
<u>Law</u> to get the maximum benefits that you have earned.

# Are Social Security Disability Benefits Taxable?



Some beneficiaries receiving Social

Security Disability (SSDI) benefits must pay federal taxes on monies received.

Generally, up to 50% of your SSDI benefits may be taxable, although up to 85% of your benefits may be taxable under certain circumstances.

To determine the taxable amount of your benefits, add 50% of your SSDI benefits to all other income, including tax—exempt interest. Any part of this total that is in excess above "base amounts" based on your federal tax filing status is taxable.

Base amounts for determining the taxability of SSDI benefits are:

- \$25,000 if you file as single, head of household, or as a qualifying widow(er),
- \$25,000 if you are married filing separately and lived apart from your spouse for the entire tax year,
- \$32,000 if you are married filing jointly, and
- \$-0- if you are married filing separately and live with your spouse at any time during the tax year.

Social Security Disability or Pension benefits are not taxable in the <u>state of</u> California.

Note: if you are eligible for <u>Supplemental Security Income (SSI) payments</u>, these are *not taxable*.


