In the past, the Social Security Administration (SSA) required the presence of another disease like arthritis when an individual with fibromyalgia applied for Social Security Disability (SSDI) benefits. Applicants with fibromyalgia were rarely approved for SSDI because there is no definitive cause for this condition and also because patients display widely varying symptoms.

SSA Issues Clarifying Eligibility Ruling in 2012

The SSA issued a welcomed ruling in July of 2012 that explains how individuals with fibromyalgia can qualify for SSDI. This ruling uses standards issued by the American College of Rheumatology and is very specific.

The ruling uses the following criteria to determine whether fibromyalgia is present:

- A history of chronic widespread pain including in the chest, neck or back, and
- Evidence such as examination notes and lab tests that shows that your doctor ruled out other diseases that have similar symptoms (for example, lupus, hypothyroidism and multiple sclerosis), and
- One of the following:
- Tenderness when palpated by the doctor in at least 11 of 18 specified <u>tender point areas</u> of the body, **or**
- Repeated occurrences of 6 or more symptoms

typically associated with fibromyalgia; some of these are memory or cognitive problems, anxiety, fatigue, depression, "fibro fog" or muscle weakness.

Hollywood's Rich Movie-Making History

Thomas A. Edison may have patented the motion picture camera, but when he and companies like Eastman Kodak formed a near–monopoly in 1908 to produce movies, other filmmakers looked to the west. California judges



were less friendly to the patents awarded to Edison and patent enforcement was tricky due to the expense of cross-country travel.

At the turn of the twentieth century, Hollywood was a sleepy agricultural community. Director D.W. Griffith's 1910 movie *In Old California* was the first movie filmed in Hollywood, chosen for its friendly people and beautiful scenery. Other filmmakers quickly followed his example. Hollywood has ideal weather and is close to camera—ready settings such as city, farms, mountains, ocean desert and orange groves.

Hollywood quickly became the center of motion pictures in America. Five major studios – Columbia, Metro Goldwyn Mayer, Paramount, RKO and Warner Brothers Pictures – took up residence. These entities not only created motion pictures but distributed and exhibited them in a stronghold called the studio system.

Hollywood became known as "Tinseltown" – a cultural icon underscoring leisure, luxury and scenes of excessive parties. But the studio system was

demolished in 1948 when the U.S. Supreme Court ruled that the studios could not own movie theatres that played only their movies or their stars' movies.

Today "Hollywood" loosely applies to most film or television production in the Los Angeles area including Burbank and Culver City, while Paramount is the only major film studio still in Tinseltown. The Hollywood aura has survived World War II, the rise of television, more youth—oriented markets, social change and new technologies and special effects to remain a huge force in the global motion picture industry.


